Purpose:

Garfield County Community Corrections must establish policy to implement and administer the client paid daily per-diem rate process established by the State of Colorado. This policy will become effective July 1, 2026. The purpose of this policy is to establish a commitment of each client in their own success and prepare them for the responsibilities they will have upon their successful completion of this program.

Policy:

Garfield County Community Corrections has established a client paid per-diem rate of eight (\$8) dollars per day for each residential client housed in the Community Corrections Program.

Procedure:

Garfield County Community Corrections (GCCC) will charge all residential clients a daily per-diem rate of \$8.00 per day for the length of their residential stay in the program. This amount will begin accrual on the day after the client's arrival at GCCC and is tracked on the individual client account on the Correct Tech software program. GCCC accounting personnel will review client accounts monthly and transfer funds from the client account to the GCCC account as available to cover client debt to the program.

GCCC understands the importance of clients orienting to the program and initializing the case planning process, so has established the following: Clients will be reviewed after they have completed the first 15 days in GCCC and their accounts will be credited the \$8 per day up to a maximum of \$112 dollars if they have been program compliant, not received any 200 level or higher disciplinary convictions and are actively employed or engaged in the employment process.

This review will be conducted by case management, and their recommendation is subject to review and final disposition by GCCC Residential Services Manager.

GCCC reserves the option to waive some or all of the daily per-diem rate for clients in exceptional circumstances. A case manager must ask for an administrative review of any such requests, and they will be staffed during one of the facilities staffing.
